




Figure 1. Typical Forward Voltage

Figure 2. Maximum Forward Voltage




Figure 3. Typical Reverse Current\*




Figure 4. Maximum Reverse Current for MURS230T3G, NRVUS230T3G




Figure 5. Maximum Reverse Current for MURS240T3G, NRVUS240T3G




Figure 6. Typical Capacitance




Figure 7. Maximum Capacitance




Figure 8. Current Derating, Case







Figure 9. Power Dissipation


